






Functional management of language ability (Reading skill activity)






Corevalues

Our Varsity girls triumphed in a fiercely contested basketball match, while in an exhilarating football showdown between Varsity boys and coaches, the coaches emerged victorious, demonstrating their seasoned skill and strategic prowess on the field.





The students gained profound insights into the causes and factors contributing to psychological disorders. We engaged with patients in both male and female wards and also explored the criminal section. This experience enabled students to discern how genetic and environmental factors can distort personality. Our final visit was to the rehabilitation center, where inmates are trained in various skills, such as art, dance, and candle making, prior to their reintegration into society. A comprehensive write-up by students and parents about these visits has been included in the four-page newsletter.





















